



Brotherhood/Sisterhood Citation Award

Since 1964, the National Conference for Community and Justice of the Piedmont Triad (NCCJ) has honored outstanding citizens who have improved our community with the Brotherhood/Sisterhood Citation Award. To identify deserving candidates, NCCJ welcomes nominations from across the Triad, especially Greensboro and High Point. The 2017 award will be presented at the 51st Annual Brotherhood/Sisterhood Citation Award Dinner in November 2017 (date to be announced.)

All nominations must be received by 5 pm on Monday, March 20, 2017. Incomplete nomination forms will not be considered. NCCJ's Citation Award Selection Committee will meet to consider all nominations. In April, NCCJ's Board of Directors will select the honoree from the nominees presented to them and all nominators will be notified by NCCJ shortly thereafter.

Read carefully: NCCJ's mission is to build a compassionate and just community free of bias, bigotry and racism. NCCJ does not advocate for any group or philosophy, but works to build mutual respect among all people—regardless of race, faith, culture, sexual orientation, gender, or socioeconomic background. Citation Award nominees must model these values in all aspects of their lives.

Eligibility

All residents of the Piedmont Triad are eligible for nomination, with the following provisions and exclusions:

- 1) The nominee may not have previously been a Citation Award honoree in the Piedmont Triad (please [see our website](#) for a full list of previous honorees);
- 2) If a nominee has been honored with the Citation Award in another community, only their work in the Piedmont Triad will be considered for this award;
- 3) The nominee may not hold elective office *except* in cases when the individual's term will be completed within the year, they have not filed for any elective office, and filing deadlines have closed;
- 4) Current NCCJ board members are generally not eligible for the Citation Award (however, in special circumstances the Selection Committee may accept nominations of current board members); and
- 5) Submissions will remain "active nominations" for a period of 3 years. You may submit additional supporting materials to enhance the application packet.
